GOULD STREET

Getting There: A little tricky by public transport! Catch the 380, 381 or 382 to Bondi Junction, then take a train to Central Station, then take the 440, 433 or 445 bus to Darling St Rozelle. By car drive into the city and from there take the Glebe Island Bridge, then the right-hand lane, which becomes Victoria St (approximately 40 minutes).
